

HOW TO EMBED OPEN STREET MAP ON YOUR OWN WEBPAGE

Modify this html code to suit your website:

```
<!DOCTYPE html>
<html lang="en">
<head>
</head>
<body>
<iframe src="https://www.qsomap.com/QSOmapProduction/qsomapforosmQRZ.php?call=yourcallsign" width="100%"
height="1100px"></iframe>
</body>
</html>
```

Obviously, replace **yourcallsign** with your callsign (e.g. ?call=n9ms)

Optional Parameters to be placed **AFTER** ?call=yourcallsign

&iconcolor=band (the default is mode) you can color the map markers either by mode or band. You will have to provide a key for your users.



Optionally add Polylines to your map by specifying either &gridin or &latlon

&gridin=grid (e.g. &gridin=FM15ag)

&latlon=latitude,longitude (e.g. &latlon=35.253836,-77.959992) **Specify EITHER &gridin OR &latlon**

&from=yyyy-mm-dd

&to=yyyy-mm-dd (e.g. &from=2025-01-01&to=2025-01-30) **Either don't specify from/to or specify them BOTH**

&limit=no (by default, the map limits the number of markers to the most recent 1000 contacts. Specifying &limit="no" overrides the 1000 marker limit) Too many markers will make your map slow to display.

Yes, the **WWW**.qsomap.com is **required**.
